

Forth Valley Disability Sport (FVDS) role in supporting clubs is a fundamental vehicle to foster the partnerships between the voluntary sector and statutory bodies involved in the provision of sport for people with a disability in the area.

Through interaction with organisation such as Sportcentral, Scottish Disability Sport, Active Stirling, Clackmannanshire, Falkirk and Stirling Councils, FVDS has the ability to distribute a whole range of information and up to date advice to affiliated members.

In their efforts to help you meet your aims, Forth Valley Disability Sport has keen committee which is made up of the following: -



Membership to Forth Valley Disability Sport can provide the following benefits for full members:

- Club Start up Grants We can offer new clubs who then affiliate a grant of up to £150.
- Coach Education Grants In order to assist with the training of any coach or official in your club we can offer up to £300 per annum.
- Special Projects Any club / organisation that runs a project with the aim to increase participation opportunities or develop the sport can receive up to £250 per annum.
- National Athletes Any athlete representing their country in competition or are training as part of national squad can receive up to £300 per annum to assist with costs.
- Specialist Equipment Assists with the purchase of any specialist equipment that may be required by an individual or club up to £150 per annum may be awarded.
- Support with Transport To assist with transportation to events and competitions.
- Professional Support Can be accessed and given through the Sportcentral Disability Sport Manager.
- Information On professional contacts, National and Local events, Disability Sports Issues etc.
- NB Associate members are not eligible to apply for grant aid.
